"HEAT ON REGULATORS" WINS ACSI MEDIA AWARD 2008

The Australian Council of Super Investors is pleased to announce the winner of the ACSI Media Award for 2008 is ABC journalist Greg Hoy.

Greg's winning piece "Heat on Regulators over Insider Trading Allegations" was broadcast on the ABC 7.30 Report on the 16 April 2008 and covered the pressure on the Australian stock market over allegations of inappropriate trading by company directors."

ACSI CEO, Ann Byrne who presented the award said "Greg's nomination was one of twelve excellent submissions received this year and selected by a panel of judges. His broadcast was chosen as the winning entry because of its eloquence in explaining a complex issue and the construction of the piece to include a wide cross section of industry views. It broadened the public's understanding of corporate governance and the need for vigilance on all the issues."

During the award ceremony, guests were also privy to a presentation from key note speaker Justin Wood, Head, Strategic Solutions and Client Advisory Group for Barclays Global Investors (BGI) Australia, who spoke about "The Principles for Governance Failure".

As winner of the award, Greg will either join 600 worldwide corporate governance experts at one of the 2008/09 International Corporate Governance Network Conferences or choose to receive a \$5,000 cash prize.

The ACSI Media Award was established in 2007 to pay tribute to journalist work which has contributed to increasing awareness and understanding of company corporate governance in the Australian media either via print or broadcasting mediums.
